

## NOTICE OF BID

Bids are requested for maintaining various Medina County Highways by installing Chip Seals, Temporary & Permanent Pavement Markings and Traffic Control as required.

Bid forms, specifications and details as to the location of the proposed improvements can be obtained daily at the Office of the **Medina County Highway Garage, 6100 Wedgewood Road, Medina, OH 44256**, by all prospective bidders between the hours of **7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.**, Ohio time, Monday through Friday.

All bids will be accepted no later than Monday, June 21, 2010, at 1:30 p.m., Ohio time, in the office of the Medina County Commissioners, Administration Building, 144 North Broadway, Medina, Ohio 44256, at which time all properly marked bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

All bids must be filed on forms provided by the County and submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked, "**2010 Medina County Chip Sealing**," at the time and date set forth above.

Completion date varies depending on type of chip seal specified for the various highways. Completion dates in effect will be either August 27, 2010 or October 1, 2010. All bidders must be qualified by experience and properly equipped to complete the work specified in the time allotted.

Each bidder shall contain the full name of each person submitting the bid.

Each bidder shall be required to file with their bid, the following:

1. A bid guarantee in the form of either;
  - a) A bond as set forth in the bid documents for the full amount of the bid, or
  - b) A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code.

A letter of credit shall be revocable only at the option of the County.

The amount of the certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit shall equal 10% of the grand total of bid.

2. A Non-Collusion Affidavit.
3. Statement of Bidder Resources and Experience.
4. Declaration of Material Assistance/Non-Assistance to a Terrorist Organization.

**Notice of Bid (cont'd.)**

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contract compliance with the Equal Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Medina County, Ohio, as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Labor and Worker Safety.

In accordance with the Ohio Revised Code Section 2903.33, the successful bidder will be required to certify that it does not provide material assistance to any organization on the United States Department of State Terrorist Exclusion list. The Terrorist Exclusion List may be found on the Ohio Homeland Security Web Site at: <http://www.homelandsecurity.ohio.gov/>. Certification shall be made by completing a Declaration Regarding Material Assistance/non-assistance to a Terrorist Organization Form.

The bid will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder. The Medina County Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
