

COMMISSIONERS PUBLIC HEARING – TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2007

Sharon A. Ray called the meeting to order with Patricia G. Geissman and Stephen D. Hambley present.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposed improvements to Stony Hill Road (C.H. 48) located approximately 1,000 feet north of Weymouth Road in Hinckley Township.

Ron Spano, Highway Engineers' Office, said the project entails the lowering of Stony Hill Road approximately 300 feet in front of a new subdivision, Tamarind Meadows, to account for the site distance to the north. The plan is to lower the road about one foot, taking out the existing road, undercutting the subgrade, preparing the subgrade, and repaving it for the safety of site distance.

Andy Conrad, Highway Engineer's Office, added that is a minor project that starts tomorrow and they hope to have the road open by the weekend.

Paul Madvack, Hinckley Township resident, said the township requests that the road be open for the township garage sale day on Saturday, September 8. Stony Hill Road is a major thoroughfare in the township. Mr. Conrad said they would make sure the road is passable and that traffic is maintained.

Ed Janovich, Time, Inc., said he would talk to somebody today and let them know.

At 11:00 a.m., Mrs. Geissman made a motion to close the public hearing. Mr. Hambley seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Roll call showed all Commissioners voting AYE.
