



**BTA's** primary goal is to provide a safe, efficient reliable customer focused transit system for all residents in the City of Brunswick. BTA operates two fixed routes that circulate through the City of Brunswick from 6:20 AM until 6:20 PM, Monday through Friday. On Saturdays, the BTA operates only from 10:20 AM until 4:20 PM. A simple wave or hand signal will hail the bus anywhere along the route. All vehicles are ADA compliant and equipped with bike racks for your convenience.

**Special Needs (ADA)**

The two buses that operate on the two fixed routes will deviate of the route up to 3/4 mile in either direction for an eligible ADA trip request (curb to curb service). Eligible ADA trip requests may be made by calling the ADA coordinator at (330) 225-7100 or (330) 723-9670 within 24 hours or up to 2 weeks in advance of the scheduled trip. To register as ADA eligible, please call the ADA coordinator at (330) 558-6804. You will receive a photo ID card at no charge and all information is kept confidential. The photo ID card should remain with you at all times as it is universal and can be utilized on any other transit system in the U.S.

**Trips**

If your trip begins in Brunswick and ends in Brunswick, please see reverse side of this schedule, and it should provide you with the appropriate information.

If your trip begins in Brunswick and terminates in Medina County outside of Brunswick, please call Medina County Public Transit (MCPT) at (330) 225-7100 Ext. 9670 (local call) or visit their website at: [http://www.ridemedinaco.org]

For out of county medical trips, please call MCPT at (330) 225-7100 Ext. 9670.

For trips to Cuyahoga County, the BTA connects directly with route #451 at Laurel Square, or you may park at Laurel Square and directly board the #451 there. Please see GCRTA'S web site for further information rta.com.

**Free Transfers**

Any rider that pays a fare on the BTA routes, may request a free transfer from the BTA driver to the other BTA route at no additional charge. Additionally, any rider that boards a BTA bus may request a free transfer from the driver enabling ther rider to transfer to an MCPT or GCRTA vehicle with no additional fare. Riders transferring to GCRTA at locations outside of Cuyahoga County will need to pay a \$1 surcharge for a trip outside of Cuyahoga County.
