## **PUBLIC HEARING**

## **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2022**

Commissioner Stephen D. Hambley opened the Public Hearing at 9:00 a.m. with Commissioner Colleen M. Swedyk and Commissioner William F. Hutson in attendance. Mr. Hambley noted that the Public Hearing was for the purpose of reviewing and receiving comments to the proposed fee increases to sewer and water rates. This was the second public hearing held for this purpose.

Sanitary Engineer Jeremy Sinko reviewed the proposed changes as follows:

- Sewer increase from \$24.73 to \$27.75 per equivalent residential unit for operation and maintenance; no change to the debt fee.
- Water Increase from \$8.70 to \$9.35 per 1000 gallons.

Both increases are proposed to take effect January 1, 2023.

There was no one from the public wishing to speak.

Mr. Hambley asked if there were any other comments, questions or concerns. There being none, Mrs. Swedyk moved to adjourn the public hearing; Mr. Hutson seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Roll call showed all commissioners voting AYE; the public hearing adjourned at 9:02 a.m.
