



## 2020 SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING DROP-OFF SERVICES Written Questions Received Addendum No. 2 – April 10, 2020

This document extends the bid opening date by two (2) weeks from April 16, 2020 to April 30, 2020, provides detail on the electronic bid opening process in lieu of an in-person bid opening, reduces the base term of the contract from five (5) years plus five (5) consecutive, single one (1) year extensions to a base term of three (3) years plus one extension of two (2) years, totaling a potential five (5) year length of contracted services. See amended Attachment B – Recycling Drop-Off Services Bid Forms attached as Attachments B.1 – Bid Form B.1, B.2 – Bid Form B.2, and B.3 – Bid Form B.3. In addition, this Addendum No. 2 includes answers to questions received in writing prior to the published 12:00 pm deadline on Wednesday, April 8, 2020. The answers to all questions are listed in red.

### 1. Medina County Solid Waste District Bid Adjustments

#### A. Legal Notice to Bidders

The Board will receive sealed bids for the Single Stream Recycling Drop-Off Services at the Medina County Sanitary Engineer's Office, 791 W. Smith Road, until 3:30 pm on April 30, 2020 which will then be opened and read aloud via a live feed broadcast on the Department's YouTube Channel (link provided below). Bid results will be posted on the website and also e-mailed to bidders. See the Amended Invitation to Bid attached hereto.

#### J. Term of Contract

Bids must be submitted on the basis of a three (3) year Contract with an option of one extension of two (2) years. The exercise of the option to extend the Contract for the additional two (2) years shall be at the option of the District but subject to the consent of the successful bidder. The District shall give notice of the intention to exercise the two (2) year extension no later than six (6) months before the end of the initial term, and the successful bidder shall give notice of its consent to the two (2) year extension within thirty (30) days after receiving the District's notice. If the successful bidder fails to respond within the thirty (30) day period the failure to respond will be taken as a denial of consent to the extension. *(Article 1 of the form of Contract attached to the bid specifications will be amended to conform to this language.)*

### Questions Received from Prospective Bidders:

2. Can we receive a copy of all questions submitted to date? If so, when can we obtain this information?
- A:** Yes. All questions that were received after Addendum No. 1, and prior to the Wednesday, March 8, 2020, 12:00 Noon deadline, and the corresponding answers, are contained herein in Addendum No. 2.
3. Will Medina county charge a tipping fee at the CPF for this material if this is where the contractor decides to have the material processed? If not, would there be any plans for a charge in the future over the term of this contract?
- A:** The Medina County Solid Waste District shall not be considered as an option for the processing of the single stream recyclables collected through this contract (II. General Information – F. Material Recovery Facility – Page 11).
4. What are the county's expectations as far as a transition plan if a new contractor is awarded the business? Timeframe for removal of old containers and placement of new? Is there an expected timeframe for this to happen?
- A:** The current Kimble contract, Article III, Part 3.2, Vehicles and Equipment, states *"...At the conclusion of this Contract, all vehicles and equipment supplied by the Contractor shall remain the property of the Contractor. If at the conclusion of this Contract a new Contractor has been awarded a Contract for continued Recycling Drop Off Services, this current Contractor shall cooperate with the new contractor to transition from the current 8-CY bins to the new bins over a District scheduled thirty (30) calendar day period so that any transition to host location(s) is seamless and allows for continued recycling opportunity."*

Attachment M, Implementation/Transition Plan, attached herein as part of Addendum No. 2, and submitted as part of the Bid Package, shall include, *"...a schedule for delivery of each of the Containers to each of the Recycling Drop-Off Centers (date specific)."* as stated in Scope of Work on page 13. The plan shall also include the dates for the creation, review,

approval, production and distribution/installation of single stream recycling drop-off container decals and a corresponding educational piece for dissemination to the public

5. **Asking for clarification on the monthly GPS report. Is this required to be submitted monthly or is it on demand?**

**A:** Monthly (pages 3 and 14).

6. **Extra yards – how are extra yards accounted for? Is the contractor compensated for servicing more material than fits in the can?**

**A:** *“The service or emptying of a single Container at a single site on a single occasion. Example: A site with 4 Containers serviced at a frequency of twice per week would have eight (8) “Lifts” per week. Note that Recyclable Materials left outside of the Containers must be collected and placed into the Container prior to emptying the Container. If the volume of Recyclable Materials left outside of the Containers exceeds the capacity of the Container and warrants a second tip, the Contractor must photo-document the consecutive tip to invoice for a second “Lift” during the same service. A second “Lift” will not be considered an unscheduled Lift as the Contractor is already at the site performing a scheduled Lift.” (page 15)*

7. **Can we obtain the number of lifts and tons delivered from 2019? If not, can we obtain a 3-year or 5-year average of number of lifts completed and tons delivered?**

**A:** Pages 9 and 10 list the Recycling Drop-Off Centers; the number of containers at each site; and the frequency/days of service. A spreadsheet showing the 2019 tonnage collected through the program has been included as part of Addendum No. 2. See Attachment L.

8. **Has the county done any auditing of the material to determine what the residual percentage on this material is? If so, can we see the results of such auditing?**

**A:** Under the existing contract for services, a 20% or less residual was to be achieved or the District would be penalized by the yard for the materials. The District has not incurred a penalty to date for their materials.

**9. Due to the timeliness of questions and the current Covid-19 situation is there any chance the District will extend the due date for the bid?**

**A:** The bid opening date has been extended by two (2) weeks to April 30, 2020. Please see Item 1(A) above.

**10. Can contractor refuse to load Contaminated recyclables? Is there an allowable percentage of contamination accepted per container?**

**A:** An individual 8-cubic yard single stream recycling container must contain by volume contaminants totaling 50% or greater, before it can be identified as needing to be serviced as trash. The Contractor shall document with photographs the materials inside the identified container. The photographs shall be sent to the District via e-mail, along with the site location information and the date that the individual container will be serviced as trash with a trash truck. The cost to dispose of the contaminated material by cubic yard shall be set forth in Attachment B.3 - Bid Form B.3, attached herein as part of Addendum No.2, to be submitted as part of the Bid Package.

**11. Can we make the renewal terms to be agreed upon mutually?**

**A:** The renewal terms have been amended per Item 1(J) above.

**12. Page 1 – Will you proceed with the pre-bid March 31, 2020?**

**A:** The pre-bid meeting was cancelled via Addendum No. 1.

**13. Page 3 states collection Mon-Saturday but the service schedule shows Mon-Fri. Is this to accommodate for holidays or is there an expectation that Saturday Service can be requested?**

**A:** The Contractor shall be required to provide Saturday service to accommodate holiday scheduling and any site necessitating regularly scheduled service on this day based on volume determined through the quarterly audit process.

**14. Page 3 states photo of unrecyclable material must be provided within 24 hours. Who is then responsible for the clean-up and disposal of material?**

**A:** The Medina County Solid Waste District is responsible for the clean-up and disposal of these materials.

**15. Page 6 – Extension years – Would the County consider mutually agreed upon extension years?**

**A:** The renewal terms have been amended per Item 1(J) above.

**16. Page 12 – Additional Service states 24 hours – Is there an expectation that this would be provided service on Saturday?**

**A:** No, with the exception of holiday scheduling.

**17. BID FORMS: You define a second lift, but do not provide a bid price to be submitted for such. Would you consider allowing second lifts to have a rate other than scheduled lifts?**

**A:** No. *“If the volume of Recyclable Materials left outside of the Containers exceeds the capacity of the Container and warrants a second tip, the Contractor must photo-document the consecutive tip to invoice for a second “Lift” during the same service.”* (page 15)

**18. BID FORMS: You define unscheduled lifts, but do not provide a bid price to be submitted for such. Would you consider allowing unscheduled lifts to have a rate other than scheduled lifts?**

**A:** Yes. The cost per unscheduled lift per container shall be set forth in Attachment B.2 - Bid Form B.2, attached herein as part of Addendum No. 2, and submitted as part of the Bid Package.

**19. BID FORMS: Would you please confirm that all 8-yard containers will be charged a lift when service is requested or provided to a site? Example, an unscheduled request would be for the site and not for one box at a site.**

**A:** Correct.

**20. Due to the COVID 19 pandemic and all the focus we are putting forth to our current service adjustments and what seems to be like hourly communications with our communities, would the County consider moving the opening date back to May 7th?**

**A:** The bid opening date has been extended by two (2) weeks to April 30, 2020. Please see Item 1(A) above.

**21. The recyclables being collected at the drop off sites are coming from the residents of the County; would we be able to deliver the recyclables to the County MRF at no charge for processing?**

**A:** The Medina County Solid Waste District shall not be considered as an option for the processing of the single stream recyclables collected through this contract (II. General Information – F. Material Recovery Facility – Page 11).

**22. Predicting recycling cost 10 months from now let alone 10 years is not a risk we are willing to take. Would the County be willing to change the extension years to mutually agreed upon?**

**A:** The renewal terms have been amended per Item 1(J) above.
