

Colleen M. Swedyk called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. with William F. Hutson and Patricia G. Geissman present. The purpose of the meeting was for the board to ascertain whether a stone-enclosed mailbox located at 1197 Remsen Road is an obstruction subject to removal or relocation from the road right-of-way pursuant to R.C. 5547.03.

Assistant Prosecutor Brian Richter stated that Mr. Jordan is going to allow the County Engineer to attempt to move the mailbox, therefore, the hearing is not needed. Mr. Richter explained that the Post Office has been there and has shown Mr. Jordan an area where the mailbox could be placed out of the right of way. Commissioner Swedyk asked if all parties are happy with the resolution of this; Mr. Richter and Michael Lear, attorney for Mr. Jordan confirmed. Commissioner Hutson stated that to be clear, the mailbox will be removed from the right-of-way. Mr. Richter stated that the Post Office had shown him a place outside of the right-of-way that will work. The County Engineer will mark off a spot where it is okay to be located. Commissioner Geissman stated that she is very pleased that the parties came to resolution on this.

Mrs. Swedyk adjourned the meeting at 10:32 a.m.
