

Commissioner Colleen Swedyk opened the Public Hearing at 11:00 a.m. Commissioners Bill Hutson and Patricia Geissman were also in attendance. The Public Hearing was for the purpose of consideration of recommendation amendments to charges and fees imposed at the Medina County Solid Waste Management District Facility.

Jeremy Sinko stated the District costs have continued to increase throughout the years, and as a way to cover costs and maintain a healthy fund balance, it is necessary to raise the gate rate from \$50/ton to \$52/ton and to increase the residential bag rate from \$1.45/bag to \$1.75/bag. It was determined that the residents and the commercial haulers should share in the rate increases.

Public Comment

Curtis Perkins inquired about the carryover balance. Mr. Sinko stated that the projected carryover balance is 15% of the revenue of which was discussed with the Solid Waste Policy Committee. Mr. Perkins asked what the actual dollar amount of the carryover would be. Mr. Sinko stated that revenue is approximately \$9M, therefore, the fund balance goal would be around \$1.3M.

There was no one else who wished to make public comment.

Commissioner Swedyk announced that the third public hearing will be held on Thursday, December 16, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. The meeting adjourned at 11:03 a.m.
