

Stephen D. Hambley called the special meeting to order at 2:01 p.m. with Colleen M. Swedyk and William F. Hutson present. The meeting was held in the commissioners' conference room. Mr. Hambley stated that the purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the Community Development Block Grant allocation applications.

Planning Services Director Denise Testa presented applications that have been received for CDBG grant funds. The following projects were submitted with a total requested funding in the amount of \$532,900:

Senior Planner Rob Henwood noted he has been in contact with a state liaison with ODSA regarding the York Township project. That project does not qualify because it is not removing an architectural barrier and providing access for handicapped adults. Additionally, Medina County is only permitted to do five projects.

With a total of \$350,000 to allocate, the commissioners agreed on the following projects: Village of Seville, Village of Lodi, Montville Township, United Way of Summit & Medina, and City of Brunswick.

Additional funding became available as a result of York Township's ineligibility, and the commissioners decided to increase funding in some projects. The commissioners noted the City of Wadsworth is guaranteed \$150,000 for the two projects listed above, and approved funding for the following projects as listed below:

Additionally, \$2,000 was reserved for the County to cover administrative costs and \$6,000 for Fair Housing.

Mrs. Swedyk moved to adjourn the meeting; Mr. Hutson seconded the motion. Roll call showed all commissioners voting AYE; the motion carried. The special commissioners meeting adjourned at 2:28 p.m.
